Kudos goes out to our RCCT board member Christy Dowdy and longtime theater member Faron Buttry for their contributions to Clinton's production of "Mame".

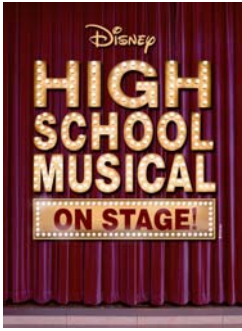
